As always,

- Cover your mouth & nose when coughing or sneezing.
- Wear your mask properly, covering both mouth & nose.

What's a "House/Cohort?" At camp, your church group will participate with 1-3 other church groups, forming a "House" or "Cohort" who will not interact directly with other Houses/Cohorts at camp.
